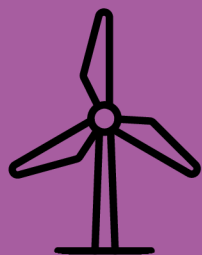

# INDUSTRIAL RELIEF

The British Industrial Competitiveness Scheme (BICS) is designed to support manufacturing frontier industries and foundational industries by exempting them from the indirect costs of three major energy levies:

**01**

**The Renewable Obligation From April 2027**

**02**

**The Feed-in Tariffs From April 2027**

**03**

**The Capacity Market From October 2027**

## THE “BRIDGE” PAYMENT:

To provide immediate certainty, the Government plans to issue a one-off payment in April 2027

This covers the support value for the 2026/27 period, effectively backdating the benefits.

# DO YOU QUALIFY?

BICS is open to businesses registered in Great Britain that fall within 'IS-8' growth sectors or critical foundational industries.

Eligibility is determined by electricity intensity (the ratio of electricity expenditure to Gross Value Added)



## FRONTIER INDUSTRIES (IS-8 GROWTH SECTORS)

Intensity must exceed 0.9%.



## FOUNDATIONAL INDUSTRIES

Intensity must exceed 2.7%

FORMULA:

$$\frac{\text{Electricity Expenditure}}{\text{Gross Value Added (GVA)}}$$

# CALCULATING YOUR EXEMPTION LEVELS

Exemption Levels: The support is pro-rated based on how much your site's electricity usage is linked to eligible manufacturing processes:



## 50% OR MORE USAGE:

100% Exemption.



## 25-50% USAGE:

50% Exemption.



## UNDER 25% USAGE

No Exemption



# KEY DATES FOR MANUFACTURING LEADERS

The consultation period has closed. Manufacturers must now prepare for a rigorous data assessment window to secure up to 100% energy relief

## 01 14 MAY 2026

The current consultation period officially closes.



## 02 OCT-NOV 2026

Businesses will be invited to provide data to the Department for Business and Trade (DBT) to identify eligibility.

## 03 8 JANUARY 2027

The DBT will confirm all eligible businesses for Year 1 of the scheme.



## 04 1 APRIL 2027

Electricity suppliers begin processing exemptions and the initial "Bridge" payments are issued.
